

Supply List

Soft Stuff

- Small quilted piece (about 12" x 15" or so) as a background to apply leaves and stems to. *The background can be any colour you like, my sample was made using a dark green mottled fabric. The quilting can be anything you like, I quilted mine to represent leaves and stems (of course!)*
- fabrics for leaves and stems- mix of lights and darks (*note- these don't necessarily have to look like leaves or stems already- consider mottled or prints with the right colours*)
- threads – mostly in colours to match or darker than the fabrics you have chosen, also bring some lighter threads for highlights.
- Batting- 80/20 poly cotton blend type works well

Other Stuff

- sewing machine and the manual for it and bobbins
- needles in various sizes to suit your chosen threads
- free motion foot for your machine and your regular presser foot
- pins
- seam ripper
- sharp, pointed scissors for fabric- they should cut right at the tips (these are essential to get a good result!!) *I like the micro-serrated ones.*
- rotary cutter and mat
- fabric markers (the frixion ones are great) or chalk wheel

- florist wire and scissors that don't matter (to cut the wire)- (*find packages of this wire at a dollar store or Michael's- or a florist*)
- notebook and pencil
- camera or phone with camera
