

## **Beginner's "Jewel Box" Quilt** (2-day class)

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2 classes to make and finish 24" x 24" quilt

### Supply List

*Note: All fabrics and threads should be 100% cotton.*

#### **Fabrics and thread:**

- fat quarter of light coloured fabric for "background" area
- fat quarter each of two different dark fabrics
- .75 meter fabric for border and binding

*(Border fabric suggestions: Recommended- an all over print is good, a print that has close values- all over medium or dark- is good, Not recommended- one way stripes or directional prints, fabrics that are very light/white with dark motifs)*

- .75 meter fabric for the back of the quilt
- 28" square of cotton or bamboo type batting such as Legacy or Hobbs- *polyester batting is NOT recommended*
- cotton thread for piecing- 50 wt (different than quilting thread) neutral gray colour
- cotton threads for quilting- we can choose in class- colour should match or be close in colour to the top layer fabrics
- fabric marker- can also be chosen in class- must be removable

#### **Tools:**

- sewing machine in good working order with the manual, regular presser foot and ¼" presser foot and walking foot or even-feed foot to fit your machine
- rotary cutter, with a new sharp blade, cutting mat and rulers. You will need a 6" square ruler and a 6" x 24" ruler. *Beginners: Please do not buy rulers with half inch added to any of these measurements. Omnigrid is the best brand, you do get what you pay for! Contact me if you have questions about this.*
- You will also need a 12 ½" square ruler (yes it's ok if this one has the extra ½" added)
- sewing machine needles- size #80 or #90 Universal or Jeans/Denim (*the size # is the important thing*)
- fine glass head or flower head pins (please don't buy the big thick yellow "quilters pins")
- pin cushion
- hand sewing needle
- scissors for cutting threads
- seam ripper
- masking tape
- 30 or so quilters curved safety pins- small or large is fine

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
