

Double Decker Applique by Machine

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Supply List

Fabrics and other stuff:

- Several sheets of plain paper- regular computer paper is fine
- Pencil and white vinyl eraser (NOT a pink one)
- Permanent marker (like Sharpie)
- Freezer paper
- Stabilizer- lightweight (optional)
- Fabrics- we will be working fairly small, but please bring a good supply of ¼ to ½ meter pieces to choose from. The more fabrics you bring, the more choices you have.
- *Ideas: bring interesting pieces that you like- colourful, those with mottled light to dark areas, bold prints (maybe black and white if you like?), stripes?*
- Cotton sewing threads- when in doubt about the colour- bring a medium gray
- Decorative threads, any or all weights- again, have some to choose from. Some will be for stitching through the needle and some can be used for couching.

Equipment:

- Sewing machine (must have at least zigzag capability) and the manual for it
- Extension cord and power bar
- Regular presser foot
- Open toe applique foot
- Couching foot if you have one
- Darning foot
- Applique/embroidery scissors (duckbill scissors if you have them)- any scissors that can cut horizontally are great
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
- Pins, seam ripper and stuff like that
- Green painters masking tape
- Basting equipment- safety pins or fusible batting, or spray baste if you use it (be prepared to do this outside!)

- Backing, binding and batting for a maximum finished piece of about 18" x 20"
