

# Fantastic Free Motion Quilting- Beyond Beginner

One-day workshop

## Supply List

- eight 10” x 20” prepared quilt sandwiches
  - *for the top, please use a good quality quilting fabric of light to medium value- any colour you like- **a plain or not a too-busy print- you will want to see your stitches and tension as you work***
  - *cotton type (or bamboo or wool) batting- not polyester*
  - *backing fabric should also be a quilting cotton*
  - *to layer -use your favourite method- safety pin basted, fusible batting or spray basted- **please have them prepared before class***
- Various cotton or polyester threads for quilting –different weights- your choice of colours- try some variegated colours. Fine embroidery thread is 60/2 ply. Regular sewing thread is 50/3 ply, heavier weights are 40/3 ply or 30 wt. Some suggested brands are Mettler, Superior, Wonderfil, and Aurifil.
- Heavy metallic or other heavy thread for bobbin quilting- Superior Threads makes “Razzle Dazzle”, YLI makes “Candlelight”, Kreinik makes various sizes of ribbon good for bobbin work.
- Water soluble thread- Superior Threads makes “Vanish-Lite”, and YLI makes “Wash-A-Way”.*(I will have some if you can't find it.)*
- Sewing machine, with the manual, extra bobbin case if you have one, regular presser foot and darning/free motion quilting foot.
- Gloves for machine quilting if you use them.
- Machine needles for quilting- any or all of these:
  - Jeans/Denim #80/12 and/or #90/14
  - Quilting #75/11 and/or #90/14
  - Topstitch #90/14 and/or #100/16
  - Embroidery #75/11 and/or #90/14
- 12” x 12” square of fluffy/thick (high loft) polyester batting.
- Pins, scissors (both blunt edge and sharp) and seam ripper.
- 12” x 6” or similar size ruler.
- Quilt marking tools/pens such as Clover Wash-out marker, Frixion pens, chalk pencils or wheels or your favourite marking tool.
- Pen, pencil and paper- several sheets of computer paper will do.
