

## Supply List

Please NOTE: We will be working in a sample form in this class so you will learn how to do several techniques and take home partly finished samples to have a record of how to do them. Please don't feel you are going to use these working samples for anything but that.

All quilt sandwiches are to be made with **100% cotton muslin or white cotton** and **cotton type batting** (not polyester)– examples of cotton type batting are Hobbs Heirloom Premium, Warm and Natural or Perfect Cotton, or Bamboo.

- 2 prepared (layered and quilted- any kind of quilting will do) rectangular 7" x 14" quilt sandwiches.
- 3 prepared (layered and quilted- any kind of quilting will do) rectangular 6" x 12" quilt sandwiches.
- 1 prepared (layered and quilted- any kind of quilting will do) rectangular 4" x 8" quilt sandwich.

**All binding and finishing samples in this class are colour coded to the instructions given out in the workshop. To save time, some pieces are prepared ahead. Label them as listed (pin a paper label to the strips) and put them all together in a plastic zip-type bag.**

From a **green cotton quilting fabric**, cut and label the following pieces:

- four 2 ½" wide strips, 5" long. Also cut two 3 ½" squares. Pin all six of these pieces together and label "facing."
- one 2 ½" wide strip, 40" to 42" long. Label "funny corners".
- six 2 ½" squares, fold each one in half diagonally and then once again, press, pin together and label "Shark's Teeth".
- one 2" wide x 10" long strip. Label "machine piping".
- two 6" x 8" rectangles. Label "hanging sleeves".

From a **red cotton quilting fabric**, cut and label the following pieces:

- three strips 2 ½" wide x 22" long. Pin together and label "2 ½" straight- continuous strip".
- two strips 2 ½" wide x 8" long, pin together and label "knife edge".
- one strip 1 ¾" wide x 4" long. Label "reversible binding".
- two 1" wide strips, one will be 4" long and the other 6" long. Label these "insert strips".

### **Please also bring:**

- **one blue fat quarter**, to be cut in class
- Neutral coloured cotton sewing thread
- Pins, scissors, seam ripper, hand sewing needle
- Paper and pencil, ball point pen, fine-tip black Sharpie pen
- Rotary cutter- (with sharp or new blade)
- Cutting mat
- Rulers, 6" x 6" and 6" x 24" or 6" x 18"
- Sewing machine, needles, walking/even feed foot, regular presser foot and ¼" presser foot
- 3 or 4 binding clips (optional)
- Iron and small board or pad (not necessary if class is in a shop)
