Supply List

Fabrics and other stuff:

- several sheets of plan paper
- pencil and white vinyl eraser (not a pink one)
- permanent marker (like sharpie)
- freezer paper
- Fabrics- we will be working fairly small, but please bring a good supply of ¼ to ½ meter pieces to choose from. The more fabrics you bring, the more choices you have. *Ideas: bring interesting pieces that you like, colourful, those with mottled light to dark areas, bold prints? Stripes?*
- Cotton sewing thread- when in doubt about the colour, bring medium gray
- Decorative threads- any or all weights- metallic, thick and/or thin. Some will be used for stitching through the needle and some can be used for couching.

Equipment:

- Sewing machine in good working order (must have at least zigzag capability) and the manual for the machine
- machine needles to suit your threads
- extension cord, power bar
- regular presser foot, open toe applique foot, couching foot if you have it, or walking foot and free motion quilting foot
- applique/embroidery scissors (duckbill scissors are great if you have these) or good blunt end scissors
- rotary cutter, mat and long ruler and large square ruler
- pins, pincushion, seam ripper etc
- green painters masking tape
- basting pins or fusible batting

- batting and backing for a maximum finished piece of about 18" x 20"
