

“Square Pegs/Round Holes”

Supply List

Fabrics:

Note: Bring fabrics in colours that you like. I suggest that you bring lights, mediums and darks. Contrast of value makes the pattern, so all of one group should be one value- for example, all four fat quarters could be light, maybe the “holes” could be all dark and the square “pegs” could be all medium. Your choice. If you have any questions, please contact me.

- four fat quarters for background fabrics
- four fabrics for “holes” (each can be .25 meter)
- four fabrics for square “pegs” (each can be .25 meter)

- about 36” square of cotton type batting
- neutral cotton thread for piecing
- fine invisible nylon or polyester thread

Machine and other hardware:

- sewing machine (with the manual if possible)- capable of zigzag stitch is helpful
- regular presser foot, ¼-inch presser foot, open toe applique foot if you have it
- rotary cutter, mat and the following rulers – large square, small square and 6” x 24” or 6” x 12”
- scissors
- seam ripper
- pins and pincushion
- freezer paper
- masking tape
- spray starch (any kind- grocery store kind or Best Press from quilt shop)
- small cheap artists brush
- iron and ironing pad or small board

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
